2016 Year End HTPA Insurance Initiative Committee Report

The HTPA Insurance Initiative Committee had another successful and busy year. This committee is Co-Led by Gail Cox and Holli Brown, and the other standing members are Brenda Fister and Irene Bigot. Two new members joined the committee in 2016, Chris Gordon and Dr. Steve Sutton.

The Insurance Initiative Committee accomplished many of their Phase 1 goals in 2015:

- Published an Energy Magazine article: *A Guide for Energy Medicine Practitioners to Help Clients Navigate their Flexible Spending Accounts* by Gail Cox (January/February 2015 issue).
- Submitted an application for a Health Care Provider Taxonomy code for Healing Touch Certified Practitioner.
- Created the Insurance Initiative Committee webpage: www.htprofessionalassociation.com/insurance-initiative-committee
- Created and produced a Video guide to help Healing Touch clients apply for HSA/FSA reimbursement for Healing Touch. (Releasing in 2016)
- Published the Healthcare Survey of practitioners to obtain information on Healing Touch as used in healthcare facilities.
- Worked on the application to establish a CPT (Current Procedural Terminology) Code for Healing Touch with the American Medical Association.

As the committee moves into 2016, much of Phase 1 work will come to fruition. They will reapply for a Provider Taxonomy code for HTCPs, which is required before applying for the NPI#. The committee is confident that they now have sufficient supporting documentation to be successful. The CPT Code Application for Healing Touch will also be completed in 2016 and submitted to the American Medical Association. Both these applications are critical for Phase 2: Apply and be accepted for Healing Touch services to be a covered service with The Center for Medicare and Medicaid.

Updating the Recommended Reading List (URRL)

This committee was created in 2016 based on suggestions from the HTPA 2015 survey results. The committee brings a wealth of experience to this one-year project!

The goal of the project is to create a one-page, user-friendly book list of up-to-date reference books for every HTPA member needing a vetted list of resources for their professional growth. The committee's work over the coming year will focus on reviewing current, well-researched contributions to the field of energy medicine; books to benefit not only ongoing professional development for practitioners, but to aid students in their Level 4 mentorship who choose to pursue Level 5 or certification. Some books, of course, are seminal to the work and some bear Janet's recommendation and the committee will honor these by retaining them on the booklist.

A comprehensive list is planned to be available online by the beginning of 2017 and a one-page, focused list will be available in the Fall of 2016 to benefit students.




