

Healing Touch Healthcare Survey

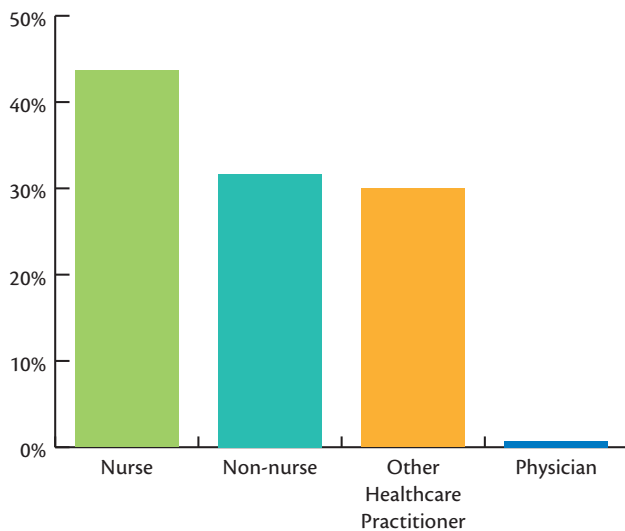
2015 Report

In July of 2015, Healing Touch Professional Association’s Insurance Initiative Committee initiated a Healthcare Survey of Healing Touch practitioners to obtain information on Healing Touch as used in healthcare facilities. The survey was created in conjunction with the Healing Touch Professional Association and Healing Touch Program. The results of this survey will provide data that will aid the Healing Touch Insurance Initiative in their endeavor to obtain the necessary codes to allow providers to insurance companies for Healing Touch.

When the survey results were considered, it became apparent that this data would be of interest to Healing Touch practitioners and may be of use to those who are interested in creating an Integrative Healing Touch Program in a healthcare facility or perhaps already have such a program. 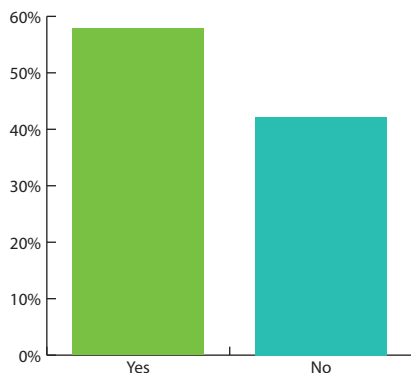
Employment in healthcare

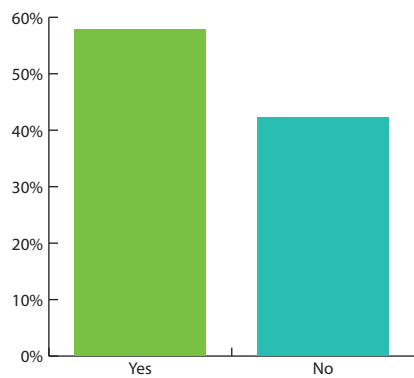
Respondents with primary employment in a healthcare facility

403 Respondents

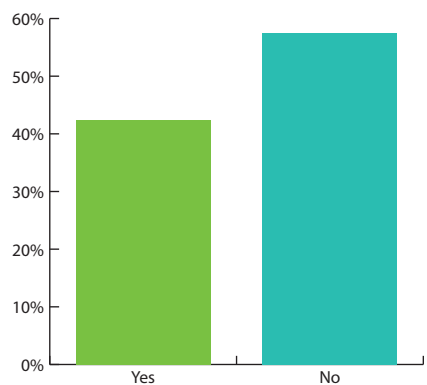
Yes - 57.82%

Document Healing Touch in patient medical record

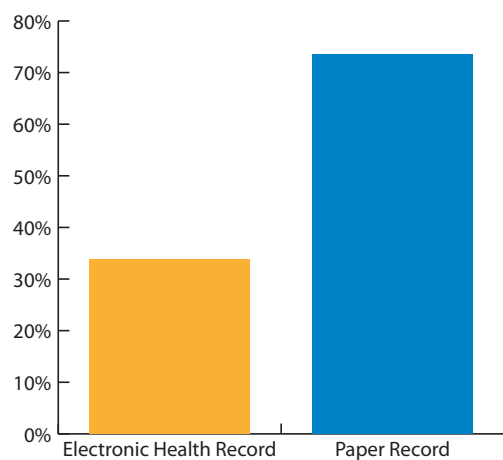

Document in electronic or paper records

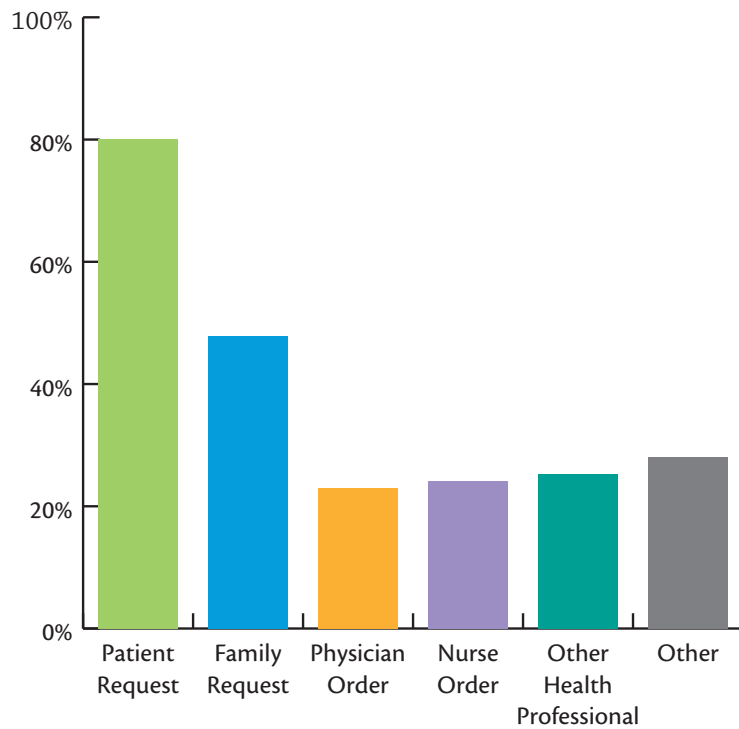


254 Respondents

Physician Order - 22.99%

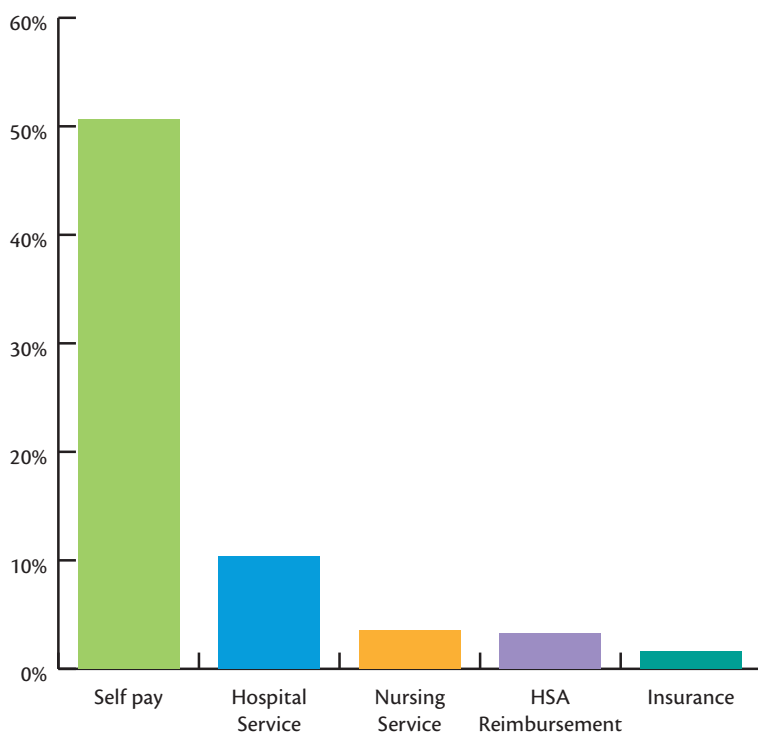
Nurse Order - 24.10%

Nursing Service - 3.56%

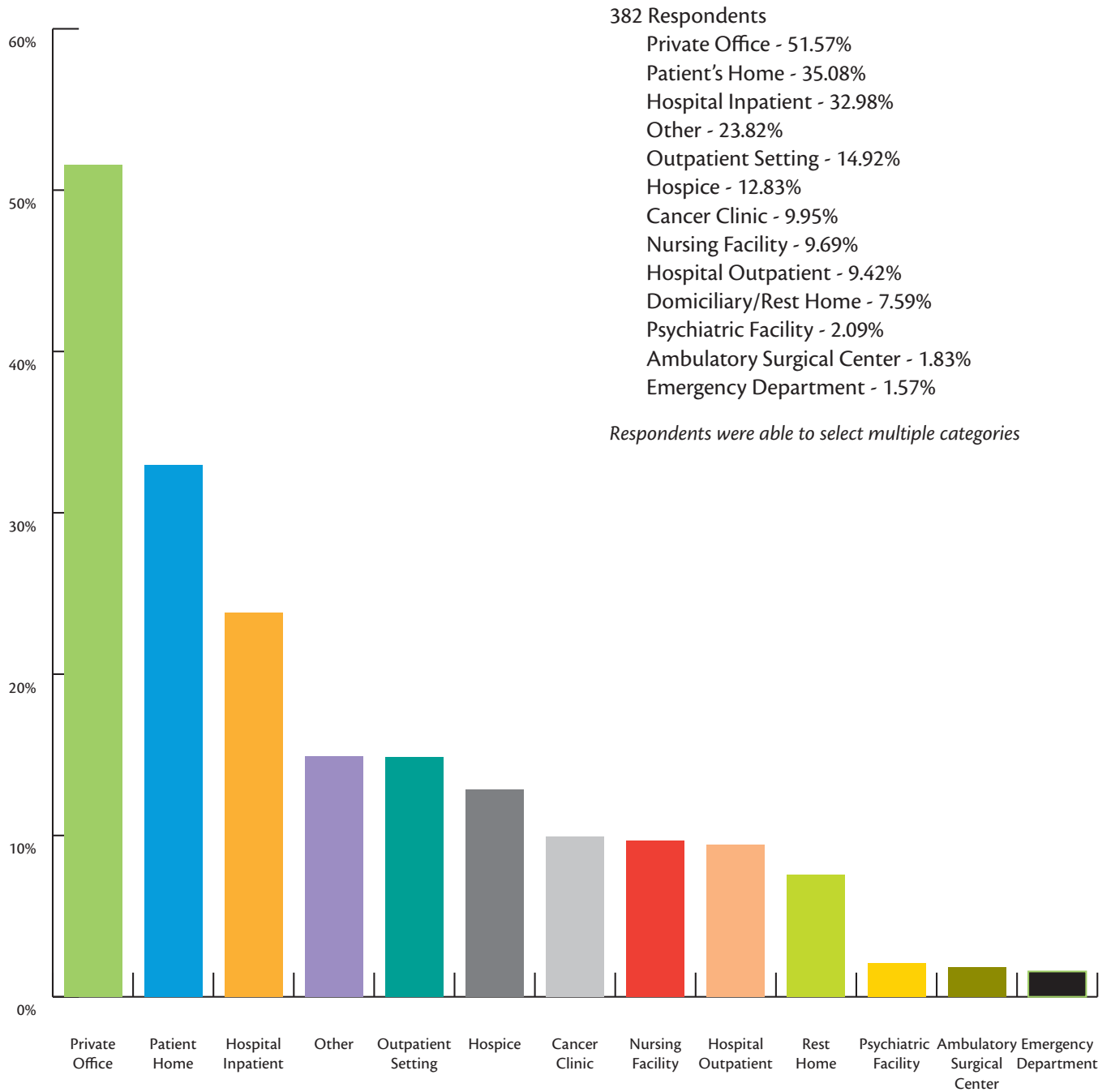
HSA Reimbursement - 3.29%

Insurance - 1.64%

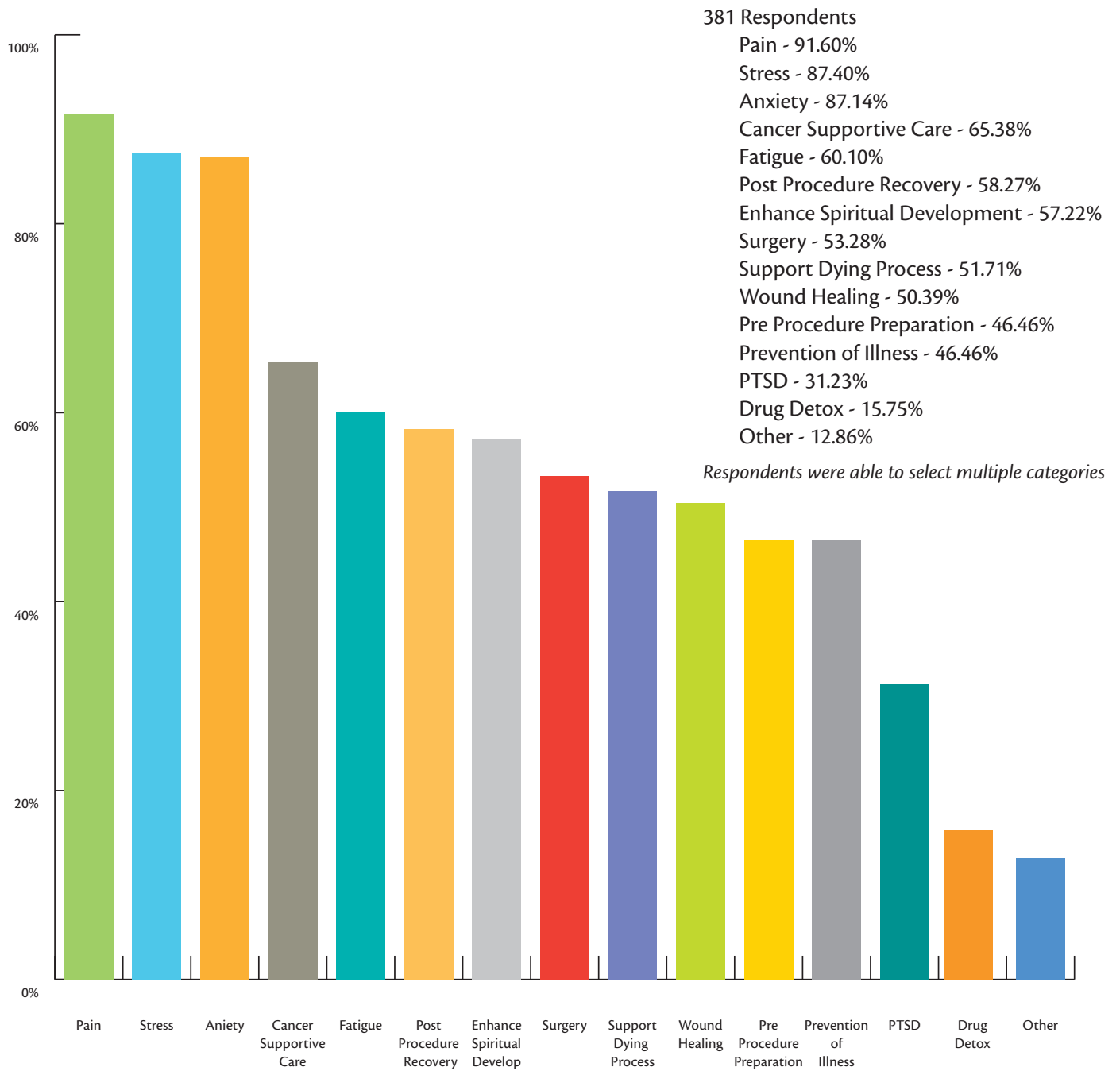
Additionally 56.99% stated they also provide HT on a voluntary basis
